We Need Judges!

This year Oregon DECA is in need of **150 business professionals** to participate in evaluating our students' competency at the State Career Development Conference in **February**. Over 700 high school students from DECA chapters across the state will be competing in over 40 competitive events for the opportunity to attend the International Career Development Conference in Louisville, Kentucky.

What is Judging?

A typical series includes a 100-point comprehensive exam, together with two activities which are demonstration role-play events. The participants are not informed of the role-play situation in advance. Prior to meeting with the judge, each student will receive a written situation to review. It may involve a product or service to sell, a merchandise decision or a problem in human relations. Students are given a set time to review the situation and to develop a professional approach to solving the problem. The students then come face to face with you, the judge, and explain how they would solve the problem. At the end of each role-play you will have an opportunity to ask the student a few questions and then score them based on provided criteria. Don't worry, the students do most of the talking!

Is There Training?

Each series event director will be training their respective judges prior to the first round of role-plays. They will demonstrate a sample role-play and review the scoring methods and criteria. You will have plenty of time to review the materials and to ask questions.

When and Where?

It is not required that you judge both days, though you may choose to do so.
