

Student Discipline Consequences

The following are general consequences that the Conference Conduct Committee and student's chapter advisor/chaperone may choose to follow:

1. Use or Possession of Drugs/Alcohol

Advisor: a) Student sent home. A student who is present when drugs/alcohol are being used is subject to the same consequence.

Committee: a) Parent and school notified.
b) Student sent home and disqualified from competition.

2. Curfew

Advisor: a) Students are expected to be in their own rooms and quiet at curfew. Any student(s) caught in the halls after state curfew may be disqualified or sent home.

Committee: a) A student(s) in violation of the stated curfew may be sent home.
b) The student will be disqualified from the previous day's event.

3. Stealing/Shoplifting

Advisor: a) Student sent home.

Committee: a) Student sent home and disqualified from competition.

4. Vandalism (including pulling fire alarms)

Advisor: a) Student who intentionally vandalizes is sent home.

Committee: a) Student sent home and disqualified from competition.

5. Cheating

Advisor: a) If an advisor has direct awareness of cheating by student(s), the information is made known to the management team or a board member immediately.

Committee: a) Student sent home and disqualified from competition.

6. Leaving Conference Area

Advisor: a) Advisors should be aware of where students are and their form of transportation.

b) An advisor who leaves the conference should check out at headquarters.

Committee: a) Students leaving conference area, without approval from their advisor, will be sent home and disqualified from competition.
